

A public seed-testing laboratory is maintained by SDSU to test seed samples for farmers, seedsmen, Crop Improvement Associations, and the South Dakota State Department of Agriculture. The lab is equipped with modern testing equipment necessary to perform tests on all kinds of agricultural crops, vegetables, trees, grass, and flower seed. It is staffed with experienced, technically trained and accredited analysts (RST) and part-time assistants who work under constant supervision. All analyses performed by the lab are made according to the Rules for Testing Seeds published by the Association of Official Seed Analysts (AOSA).
