MANAGEMENT DECLARATION: We, the management of the above-mentioned bulk seed handling facility, agree to the following as requirements for approval as a MCIA Bulk Seed Handling Facility. We shall:
 Adhere to MCIA requirements and procedures for seed certification and/or other MCIA programs. Comply with the Federal Seed Act and Minnesota State Seed Law. Respect intellectual property rights and adhere to license, patent, and PVP requirements. Operate facility in a manner that preserves the quality of certified seed. Make facility and records available for inspection upon request by MCIA. Permit MCIA personnel to draw samples from certified and/or QA seed lots. Maintain complete, accurate, and current records that account for all incoming seed and the final disposition of seed. Properly use bulk seed sale certificates to identify only qualified seed lots. Perform required corrective actions as directed by MCIA through inspection reports. Notify MCIA of changes in plant management, designated personnel, and additional crop(s) to be processed prior to personnel performing seed certification functions. Be a member in good standing of the MCIA including timely payment of required fees.
