The **Minnesota Crop Improvement Association (MCIA)** is seeking applicants to fill corn field inspector positions. These positions are classified as “seasonal” and are part-time. Field inspections are performed at specified stages of crop maturity in the summer. MCIA offers flexible working hours depending on the applicant's schedule. The availability of field inspection positions varies throughout Minnesota - most available positions are located within close proximity to Becker, Cokato, Hastings, Olivia, Nicollet, and various other areas near the major corn seed production areas. - TITLE:** Field Inspector - Corn
- POSITION OPEN:** July to early August. Semi-flexible working hours can be arranged to fit the applicant's schedule.
- LOCATION:** Positions available within close proximity to Becker, Cokato, Hastings, Olivia, Nicollet, and various other areas near major corn seed production areas.
- MAIN FUNCTION:** To inspect seed corn crop production fields enrolled in MCIA programs.
- DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES:** Inspect seed corn crops to verify that fields meet specified standards for varietal purity, isolation and detasseling requirements and to ensure that the seed produced will be suitable for stated purposes. Communicate inspection results through timely, clear, concise written reports.
- QUALIFICATIONS:** Minimum - High school graduate desired. Knowledge of corn crop seed production is desirable. Persons in these positions must be detail oriented and have the ability to communicate their findings in a timely manner through concise written reports. Experience with computers is helpful. Applicants must have a valid driver's license, motor vehicle insurance and a satisfactory driving record.
- PHYSICAL DEMANDS:** Persons in these positions must have good eyesight (with or without corrective lenses) and be able to do a significant amount of walking in order to accurately determine the condition of fields.
- WAGES/BENEFITS:** MCIA offers competitive hourly wages commensurate with background, education and experience. MCIA will provide training and supervision for all inspectors. Inspectors must provide their own vehicle and will be reimbursed for mileage, postage, supplies and phone expenses.
