Kuntz - Medium maturity and very good test weight. It has standard semi-dwarf height and very strong straw strength. It is moderately resistant to the prevalent races of leaf rust. Foliar disease protection is very good. Kuntz has intermediate tolerance to scab. Protein is medium-low and overall breadmaking characteristics are satisfactory. Kuntz is broadly adapted to the spring wheat growing areas of North and South Dakota, Minnesota and Montana. Released by AgriPro in 2007. PVP(94).
