Varieties Released in 2020

Last spring, MCIA distributed **MN-Torgy** wheat, which performed very well in Minnesota trials this past year. **Warrior** oat from South Dakota, had a limited distribution in 2020. You can find the *2020 Field Crop Trials* on the Minnesota Ag Experiment Station website <https://z.umn.edu/2020croptrials>. Seed supplies are good at this time, but order early for best availability.

MN-Torgy is a hard red spring wheat that combines high yield, good protein, and disease resistance. It continues to show very strong yield performance in state and regional trials. MN-Torgy has a very good rating for bacterial leaf streak (BLS) and a good *Fusarium* head blight (FHB) rating. Grain quality is also a plus as it has a good rating for pre-harvest sprouting, above average protein, and good test weight. Released by the Minnesota Agricultural Experiment Station. The name MN-Torgy was selected to recognize Dave Torgerson, longtime executive director of the Minnesota Wheat Growers Association and Minnesota Wheat Research and Promotion Council.

Warrior is a white-hulled, spring oat released by the South Dakota Agricultural Experiment Station (SDAES). It is a medium maturing line, with average height and very good straw strength. Warrior has high yield potential and good test weight. The variety is resistant to crown rust, moderately resistant to smut and average resistance to barley yellow dwarf virus (BYDV). A royalty will be collected on all sales of certified seed. Like other South Dakota varieties there is no saleable registered class of seed.

Both **MN-Torgy** wheat and **Warrior** oats will be protected through the Plant Variety Protection Act (PVPA) with the Title V certification option.
