- ▶ A program to assure that sod types meet Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT) specifications
- ▶ University researchers determine seed mixes appropriate for tough environments, such as highly salted roadsides
- ▶ Sod provides immediate erosion control on construction sites
- ▶ A joint effort of the Minnesota Sod Producers, University of Minnesota, MnDOT, and MCIATM
