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## Varieties Released in 2019

Last spring MCIA distributed **MN-Washburn wheat**, **MN-Pearl** and **Saddle oat**. All three varieties performed well in Minnesota trials this past year. **Esker2020 oat** had a limited distribution in 2019. You can find the 2019 Field Crop Trials on the Minnesota Ag Experiment Station website <https://www.maes.umn.edu/publications/field-crop-trials/2019trials> Seed Supplies are good at this time but order early for best availability.

**MN-Washburn** wheat combines straw strength, yield, and disease resistance. Resistant to pre-harvest sprouting, it has yielded well in state trials. In addition to very good lodging resistance, MN-Washburn has very good ratings for Bacterial leaf streak and Fusarium head blight; excellent ratings for leaf rust and stripe rust and resistance to Barley Yellow Dwarf Virus (BYDV).

**MN-Pearl** oat is a white hulled variety with very high yield and good straw strength. It is similar in maturity and height to Deon. MN-Pearl has high groat percentage and good test weight. It is smut resistant and has moderate crown rust resistance.

**Saddle** oat is an early maturing variety with very good yields. Released by South Dakota, it has strong straw and a good rating for crown rust resistance. A white oat, Saddle has good test weight and high groat percentage. There is no Saleable Registered seed class for Saddle.

**Esker2020** oat is a new release from the University of Wisconsin. It has medium maturity and yielded well in Minnesota trials. In Wisconsin trials, Esker2020 has a very good crown rust rating, good straw strength and test weight. There is no Registered seed class for Esker2020.
