Shipping Seed to Canada?

There may be more demand from Canada for Minnesota grown certified seed. Before shipping any seed to Canada you need to verify if the party is licensed to handle that variety in Canada. If the variety is not licensed in Canada it cannot be exported. Several North Dakota varieties are licensed while only a few Minnesota varieties have licensed partners in Canada. So before shipping any seed to Canada make sure the buyer is properly licensed. Shipping unlicensed varieties to Canada limits the ability to protect the variety and control seed shipments back in to the USA. Contact MCIA if you have any questions.
