Seed Certification and Testing

An analysis report from a seed testing lab does not represent certified seed. A seed lot is not certified until a passed Seed Certification Report is issued by MCIA and a certification label is attached or a Bulk Sales Certificate is issued to the buyer.

Test Seed Now – Don't wait to send in your samples for testing. Submitting samples early will ensure you have the results when you need them. Any issues or concerns can be addressed before selling and shipping seed. Contact the MCIA office for questions regarding the sample submission process when submitting certified seed samples.

Foundation Seed and New Variety Information

Information on the new varieties for 2012 was recently mailed to eligible members and county extension offices. Down payments were due by February 15. New releases being distributed include Norden wheat and Horsepower oats.
