Remember the Changes to Horsepower & Shelby 427 Oats

The SDSU oat varieties Horsepower, Goliath and Shelby 427 were changed to a non-saleable Registered seed class. This means you cannot sell Registered seed. You can use your production of non-saleable Registered seed to produce your own certified seed or downgrade it to Certified class seed for sales.

Plan accordingly when ordering Foundation seed.
