REMINDER: Ready for Spring?

Planting season will be here soon. The seed lab is busy, so don't delay in getting your seed tested. At best it will take 7 days and we need test results before issuing final reports, bulk certificates, and tags. A few other items to keep in mind:

- Always tag or issue bulk certificates for the seed you distribute
- Be sure you received a passed seed certification report before any tags or bulk certificates are issued
- Resolve any issues about eligibility of seed source before planting

Save Your Proof of Seed Source

When you pick up seed, be sure that it is properly tagged or that you receive a bulk certificate. Save these documents for proof of seed source. MCIA will mail Field Inspection information packets in May.

Foundation Seed and New Variety Information

Seed Available: We are still accepting orders for Foundation seed of barley, oats, soybeans, and wheat. Please include full payment when ordering.

New Varieties: Invoices have been mailed to those who received a new variety allocation. Please make payment immediately, so you can pick up your seed in a timely manner.

Seed Pickup: Full payment is due before you can pick up your Foundation seed order. Remember to contact your seed distributor ahead of time to make arrangements to pick up seed. Call MCIA for additional information or if you have questions.
