Varieties Released in 2012

The following varieties were released in 2012 and are available in limited supply: Norden spring wheat and Horsepower oats. These varieties require a license agreement and a variety development fee or royalty will be assessed.

Norden Spring Wheat

Norden packages a competitive yield with high test weight. Yields have been consistent between northern and southern locations. It is also noted for having very good straw strength. Norden is a medium maturity variety similar to Faller but is slightly shorter in height. It has very good leaf and stem rust resistance and a good scab rating. Protein levels are slightly better than Prosper with acceptable milling and baking qualities. Plant Variety Protection(PVP) with the Title V certification will be made for Norden.

Horsepower Oats

Horsepower, is a medium-early white-hulled oat, developed by the South Dakota Agricultural Experiment Station. In Minnesota trials it is 1-2 days later than Colt and slightly shorter with better straw strength. Horsepower has good test weight and moderate resistance to crown rust and Barley Yellow Dwarf Virus(BYDV) and moderately susceptible to smut and stem rust. Plant Variety Protection (PVP) with the Title V certification will be made for Horsepower.
