Varieties Released in 2014

Elgin-ND spring wheat and MN0808CN soybeans, released in 2014 are available in limited supply. These varieties require a license agreement and a variety development fee or royalty will be assessed.

Elgin-ND hard red spring wheat is widely adapted to the spring wheat-growing region of the Upper Midwest. It has high yield potential and is similar in maturity to Faller. Elgin-ND has good straw strength similar to Faller and Prosper but it is slightly taller. It has above average protein, average test weight and good milling and baking qualities. Elgin-ND possesses a good disease resistance package with a moderate scab rating and resistance to prevalent races of leaf and stem rust. Developed by the North Dakota Ag Experiment Station.

MN0808CN soybean is the latest general use variety to be released. It is a soybean cyst nematode (SCN) resistant line with a relative maturity of 0.8. It is 1-2 days later than Sheyenne and about five days earlier than MN1410. MN0808CN carries the *Rps1c* gene for phytophthora resistance, average tolerance to iron chlorosis and good lodging resistance. It has average protein and oil content and a yellow hilum. With a maturity and yield similar to Sheyenne, MN0808CN is a good option for a non-GMO soybean variety with SCN resistance. SDSU Royalty Rates to Increase

Royalty rates for South Dakota State University developed varieties will increase beginning July 1, 2015. The royalty rates for spring and winter wheat will be \$.60/bushel and oats will be \$.30/bushel. This includes all previously released varieties including Horsepower and Shelby 427 oats and Forefront wheat.
