Aroostook—A winter rye selected for use as a cover crop plant for short growing season areas following late harvested crops. It is an early, tall cereal grain with narrow dark leaves and good winter hardiness. Yields vary depending on weather, soil fertility, and planting and harvesting dates. Released in 1981 in cooperation with the USDA Natural Resources Conservation Service, the New York State College of Agriculture and Life Sciences, Cornell University, and the Maine Department of Agriculture, Division of Plant Industry.

Spooner—A high yielding winter rye. Grain yields and test weights exceed those of Hancock; heads one day earlier and has excellent winter hardiness. It is tall, averaging about 3 inches taller than Hancock with less lodging. Developed at the University of Wisconsin Madison and released in 1992.

Emerson—A hard red winter wheat with acceptable grain yield, excellent agronomic and end-use quality traits, and superior resistance to stem rust, leaf rust, stripe rust and Fusarium head blight make Emerson particularly well suited to the eastern prairie production environment. It was developed by Lethbridge Research Centre of Agriculture and AgriFood Canada.

Expedition—A hard red winter wheat, awned, white-chaffed, early maturing, semi-dwarf. Plant height is short, winter hardiness is rated good-excellent. Straw strength is fair. Expedition is resistant to prevalent races of stem rust, however, is moderately susceptible to leaf rust. It exhibits some tolerance to head scab but is susceptible to tan spot and Hessian fly and had an intermediate reaction to soil-borne mosaic virus. End-use characteristics are rated acceptable overall. Released by South Dakota Agricultural Experiment Station in 2003. PVP(94) Title V.

Ideal is moderately susceptible to stripe rust and susceptible to head scab, but it exhibits moderate resistance to tan spot, leaf and stem rust. Released by the South Dakota Agricultural Experiment Station in 2011. License required for seed production. PVP(94) Title V.

It is moderately susceptible to leaf rust, moderately susceptible to moderately resistant to stripe rust, and susceptible to wheat streak mosaic virus. Released by the South Dakota Agricultural Experiment Station in 2013. License required for seed production. PVP (94) Title V is applied for.
